

WHAT IS THE EUI? About the Initiative





EUI is a European Union instrument and is managed by the European Commission's DG Regional and Urban Policy.

EUI has a total **ERDF budget of €450 million** for 2021-2027.

The European Urban Initiative is an essential tool to support cities of **all sizes**, to build **capacity** and **knowledge**, to support **innovation** and develop **transferable** and **scalable** innovative solutions to **urban challenges of EU relevance**.



MAIN FEATURES OF

an Innovative Actions project

- Innovative projects (new, untested solutions in Europe) with the potential to be replicated in other European cities
- Support of up to EUR **5 million ERDF** (maximum co-financing rate of 80%)
- Beneficiaries: urban authorities (associations or groupings of urban authorities) with a total population of more than **50 000 inhabitants**
- Implementation period: **3.5 years**(+ 6 months of Project Initiation Phase and 3 months for administrative closure of activities)
- Thematic scope of support: each time defined by the European Commission and based on themes identified in the **Urban Agenda for the EU**; First call for proposals: **New European Bauhaus**Second call for proposals: **Greening cities, Sustainable tourism, Harnessing talent in shrinking cities**
